MATERIALS	INSTRUCTIONS	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE
<p>NEWSPAPER/MAGAZINES/CATALOGS newspaper, magazines, catalogs, phone books, hard/soft cover books</p> 		<p>DO NOT RECYCLE no plastic bags – you may return them to the store; napkins, tissue paper, paper towels, wax paper, wrapping paper, any food soiled paper, string</p>
<p>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD all brown corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, box board (shoe gift, cereal, cake mix, macaroni, pizza frozen food boxes, beer/pop cases),</p> 	<p>discard food soiled portion of pizza box</p>	<p>DO NOT RECYCLE waxed corrugated cardboard, cardboard lined with foam, cores from carpet rolls or any items made of laminated sheets of paper or cardboard</p>
<p>LARGE PLASTIC plastic furniture, plastic toys, playground toys, pails, laundry baskets</p> 	<p>remove all metal axles, handles (set beside recycle bin)</p>	<p>DO NOT RECYCLE any styrofoam</p>
<p>PLASTIC CONTAINERS narrow & wide-mouth containers</p> 	<p>plastics #1 – 7 accepted, rinse & drain thoroughly, also include wide mouth containers (tub butter, cottage cheese, yogurt, whip topping containers)</p>	<p>DO NOT RECYCLE plastic bags, medicine bottles, plexiglas, fast food containers, snack bags, Tupperware (because of residue), bubble wrap, packing peanuts, motor oil cans, anti-freeze containers</p>
<p>METAL CANS all metal food and beverage containers (cans), metal lids, closure caps, aluminum pie tins, clean aluminum foil, silverware, metal/cardboard containers (frozen juice), metal cookware</p> 	<p>rinse thoroughly & drain, aerosol cans MUST be empty.</p>	<p>DO NOT RECYCLE propane cylinders – you may take them to Wendt's Propane in Sanborn; small appliances, paint cans, hypodermic syringes – you may dispose of them at any medical facility; all rechargeable batteries may be taken to Home Depot; motor oil cans</p>
<p>MILK/JUICE CARTONS DRINK BOXES gable top beverages, containers including those with plastic spouts, straws, drink pouches</p> 	<p>rinse thoroughly & drain</p>	
<p>GLASS BOTTLES all clear, green and brown, food and beverage containers</p> 	<p>rinse thoroughly & drain</p>	<p>DO NOT RECYCLE ceramic bottles and other ceramic items, flower pots, crystal, CFL light bulbs only may be taken to Hazman- 998-8073 or Frey Electric -874-1710; mirror & window glass, heat resistant ovenware, hypodermic syringes – you may dispose of them at any medical facility; eyeglasses</p>
