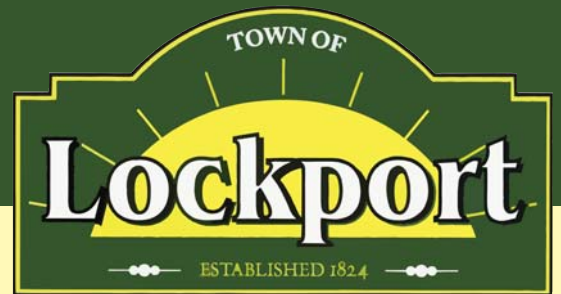

Modern Minutemen

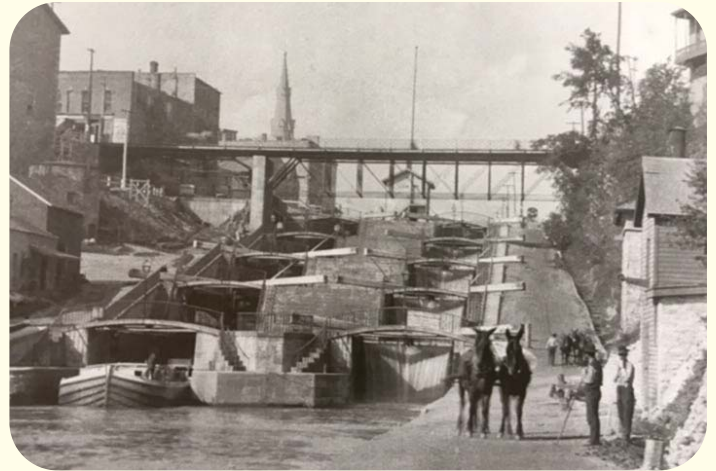

Many of these became roads in the 1800's and were frequently named for the people residing



there. The history of the Town of Lockport changed radically when this area was chosen as the place where the Erie Barge Canal would ascend the escarpment.

- By law, all cats, dogs and domesticated ferrets must have a current rabies vaccination from four months of age and on.
 - Cats and dogs receiving immunization WITHOUT PROOF of a previous rabies immunization will receive a certificate valid only for one year. Cats and dogs WITH PROOF of previous rabies immunizations will receive a certificate valid for three years.
 - Ferrets must receive vaccinations annually, regardless of previous immunization.
 - All Animals** must be properly restrained. Cats & Ferrets must be in a box or carrier. Dogs must be leashed.
 - The Department does not offer dog or cat vaccinations other than rabies. It is very important for the health and well being of your animal and the other animals attending our rabies clinics, that they have seen a veterinarian and are up to date on all of their immunizations, to include dog parvo virus.**
 - Volunteers are needed. Please call 439-7511 if interested.
 - It is requested that anyone bringing more than six animals to one clinic contact the Niagara County Department of Health at **439-7511** up to one week prior to the clinic so paperwork can be processed more efficiently.

Refuse/Recycling Pick Up

Please remember to have your garbage/recycling out by 6 am. Also, if your garbage/recycling haven't been picked up, remember there may be a few things that have happened. The truck could've broken down, a new driver may be doing the route and they do have to empty the truck. If you still haven't been picked up by 3 pm, please call the highway office at 439-9522. The highway clerk will call our representative from Waste Management to find out what is happening. Also, Waste Management only has major holidays off: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Included in this newsletter is a 2018 Recycling schedule. You can also find it on our website at elockport.com under highway. If you don't have access to a computer or you misplace this newsletter, call the highway office, 439-9522, and the clerk will mail one to you.

If you would like to purchase another recycling tote you may do so at the town clerk's office. The 65 gallon totes are \$45.00 and the 96 gallon are \$50.00. The town clerk's office will inform the highway clerk and she will have one delivered.

Mailboxes

If your mailbox is hit by our snowplows, please call the highway office. We will replace it with a standard mailbox. If you live on a county road, you will need to call 439-7360. If you live on a state road you will need to call 438-2396.

Brush Pick Up

Brush pick up is the third Monday of the month from March – November. Please have it out by Sunday night. The highway department picks up brush throughout the town. Please be patient if your brush hasn't been picked up on Monday, it will be soon after.

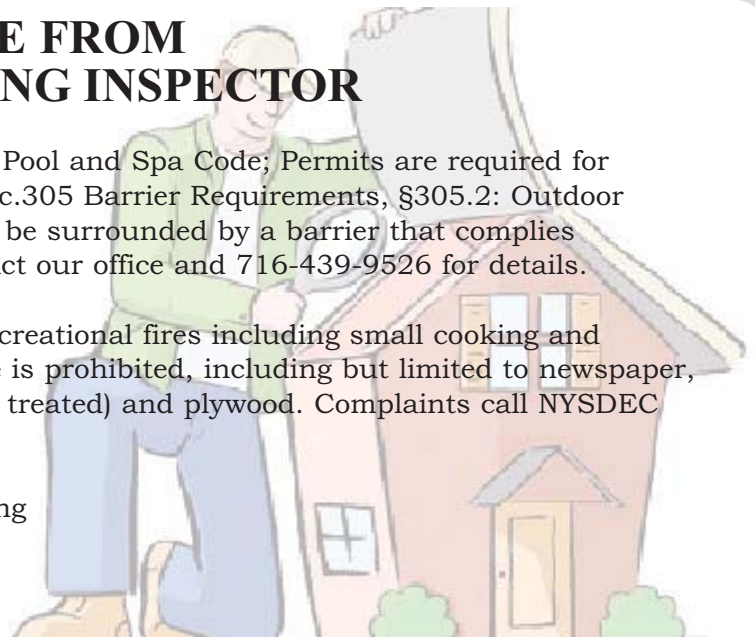

NYSDEC: Open burning is permitted for small recreational fires including small cooking and Campfires. Burning of waste products or garbage is prohibited, including but limited to newspaper, paper, plastic, chemically treated wood (pressure treated) and plywood. Complaints call NYSDEC @1-877-457-5680

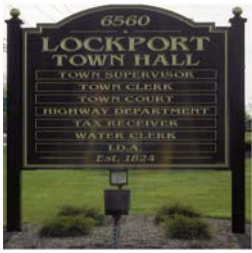
